There will be bridging revision and topics in preparation for Year 7. Share your child's book and ask them to explain mental and written strategies to you. Asking why do you think that? and how do you know? Are very important questions.					
Languages Mme Tourigny Mrs Barnes	French: Encourage your child to tell you what they have learned in French. We will be learning more complicated grammar structures. The children will prepare a short presentation on a subject of their choice, in order to encourage writing longer sentences and improving their speaking abilities. Ask them about their choice of topic for their presentation. Latin: Learn all vocabulary and grammar as it is introduced.					
Science & Technology Mrs Byrne Mr Phillips	Science: This term we will be looking at light: what it is, how it travels, shadows and rainbows. We will also be looking and researching into how we can keep our bodies healthy. Please look together at food labels, how much you exercise, how much telly and computer games you play and how much sleep you get and discuss! Computing: Your child can be creative on the computer/ tablet and practice making videos, sounds and interactive activities using the websites and software used at school.

Encourage them to ask questions RE: We will be looking at some similarities and differences between beliefs about life after death so if they come home with further questions or want to share, then please give them space to do so. Geography: All children will undertake an independent study project this term. For most, this will focus on a contrasting locality using experiences from the residential trip to Slapton Ley! Please encourage children to work a little on their project every night rather than leaving it to the last minute.
