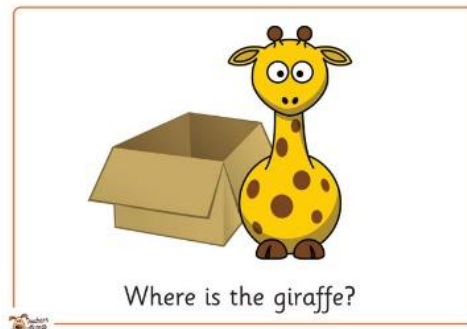
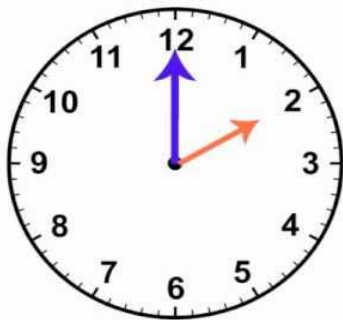


## Some of the things that the children will experience in the coming weeks...

Our literacy work will continue to be based around 'Little Rabbit Foo Foo.' We will be adding alternative text and creating and describing our own 'goonies.' We will identify the good and bad characters in the story and talk about the way they behave.

In maths we will be learning to use language related to time such as **yesterday, today, tomorrow, morning, afternoon, evening** and **night**. We will be looking at o'clock times and linking times to our daily routines. We will also be using positional language practically in simple games.

## How to help your child at home...

- Continue to practise doing up zips/buttons and encourage the children to dress independently
- Encourage the children to write/mark make to help secure pencil grips
- Ask the children to retell the stories we've been sharing in class – 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' and 'Little Rabbit Foo Foo.'
- Talk about patterns and shapes you can find around the house
- Talk about daily routines and link to times of the day
