


Reception Class Round-Up


Some of the things the children have been learning.....

We have continued to practise our doubles to 20 and started to learn to read o'clock times on clock faces.






We have used the story 'One Snowy Night' to inspire our learning in literacy. We have written about what we do to feel cosy, labelled animals and sequenced the story.
