

Some of the lovely things the children have been learning...

We have been learning to write simple lists. We helped write a shopping list for 'Mrs Pirate,' and wrote our own lists using picture cue cards. We've been having great fun in role as pirates and created 'wanted' posters and paper plate pirate faces.

We have been comparing and ordering numbers to 20 and revisited the number before and after up to 20. We have used a number line to jump on to solve simple addition problems.



We have been busy rehearsing 'Hat's Off' and look forward to our dress rehearsal and performance next week.

The children have revisited time in maths and secured ordering the days of the week and months of the year. Everybody made a paper plate clock face and practised showing and reading o'clock times.

Some of the things the children will be learning in the weeks to come...

In maths, we will partition numbers and practise number bonds to 10.

Using our focus text, 'The Night Pirates' we will be writing labels and captions on treasure maps and investigating objects that float and sink.

In handwriting we will be moving onto Zac the Grey Sheep's family of short sloping line letters. Cursive e and v will be introduced.

<u>fr</u> as in frog







How to help your child at home...

- Practise simple addition and subtraction to solve real life problems. Encourage children to count on from the bigger number
- Continue to practise doubles to 20 so children can recall facts quickly
- Practise writing full names in a cursive style. Remind children to consider letter size and position on the line
- Ask the children to tell you about the blends they have been learning in phonics
