English Mrs Symons	<p>We have some exciting objectives including adventure writing from 'The Hodgeheg' and creating an anthology of poems, as well as looking at persuasive writing and information texts. Continue encouraging your child to read and discuss their book every day. Enjoy shared reading together. Support the children by getting them to quiz regularly and read with them daily, whether they are reading to you, you to them or a mixture.</p> <p>Help them to learn their weekly spellings (including high frequency spellings if necessary). Encourage accurate size, orientation and formation of letters in cursive handwriting.</p> <p>Our GL Assessments and Criterion writing assessment will take place in the W/C 10th June. A Star reading assessment will take place this term.</p>
Maths Mrs Symons	<p>As we revisit concepts for end of year assessments, please encourage your child to work through activities on Abacus and other written or electronic tasks in areas they feel less confident in. Children should be secure in knowing their x3 and x4 tables and those secure in these should be able to recall the x6 and x8 table too. We shall be working with mental and written methods in multiplication and division and understanding that one is the inverse of the other. Get baking too! We have a unit on weights and measure coming up.</p> <p>GL Assessment will take place in W/C 10th June</p>
Modern Foreign Languages Mrs Day	<p>Ask your child to teach you Spanish words! Our topics this term include greetings, introducing yourself, numbers, and musical instruments. We will also learn the vocabulary for pets and rooms in the house.</p> <p>Pupils can use the Language Angels website in order to practise many of the topics we study. Science/DT Mrs Johnson Computing Mr Adkins	<p>Science/DT: Talk to your child about plants, their different parts and what they need to grow. Help them identify different types of plants in the garden or park. Your child will be learning about the human skeleton and how humans receive nutrition from the foods they eat. Before the half-term the children will be recapping on different topics in preparation for their end of year GL assessment.</p> <p>Computing: This term we will be looking at the wonderful world of coding and programming, designing and creating detailed algorithms in Scratch to make our own computer games. There are lots of fun ways to continue to explore this outside of school, including the Scratch.mit.edu website, Hour of Code and Swift Playgrounds on iPads. At home it would be fantastic to continue to practise word processing and keyboard skills, typing.com is the ideal tool to do this!</p>
Humanities Mrs Symons Ms Forth RE Mrs Stapleton	<p>History: Share books and programmes on Stone age to Iron age times and visit relevant historical sites - go to ourwarwickshire.org.uk to find locations. We will be learning about both time periods and how one developed into the other. Chronology will play a part in this, so practise putting events in time order, from the oldest to the most recent.</p> <p>Geography: How can you as a family help the plight of endangered animals on a small or larger scale? What products do you buy that you could stop? E.g. Shell souvenirs or bobble hats with real fur pompoms.</p> <p>RE: We shall continue exploring the life of the Buddha and considering the key practices of giving, kindness, harmlessness and meditation. Do these feature in your everyday lives?</p>

Performing and Creative Arts Mrs Barnes Mrs Thackway Mrs Johnson Miss Bowdige	Music: There will be a recorder test and a written test on music notation before half-term to assess learning. Encourage your child to prepare carefully for both tests. Art: The children will be exploring outdoor sculpture and how it can be used to enhance and improve the environment in which we live in. They will be working in groups to design and create sculptures for a chosen location within the school grounds. They will be comparing the ideas, methods and approaches used in the work of different sculptors. DT: To think about how things are made and the process a designer would go through in creating something. Cutting skills would be good to practise. Speech and Drama: Encourage your child to speak with clear diction and to use character voices when reading aloud. Help your child to learn any lines they have been given. If possible, take your child to the theatre to see a musical or play and talk to them about the performance they have seen – what did they enjoy about the performance?
Sport Mrs McCollin and Mr Adkins	Encourage enthusiasm for all sports by playing target, throwing and catching or goal games outside and going for walks or bike rides. Discuss working as a team and effective tactics when watching or playing sports. Help your child become increasingly independent and organised by encouraging them sort and pack their sports kit the night before their PE/Games lessons.
