English Mrs Emery	Encourage your child to read aloud every day and enjoy shared reading together. Allow them times to choose their own books and to read them independently. Continue to learn weekly spellings and encourage writing at home as much as possible. Writing spelling words in independent sentences and focussing on capital letters and full stops is beneficial.					
Mathematics	Keep practising number bonds to 10, 20 and 100.					
Mrs Emery	Learn 2x, 10x, 5x and 3x tables. Allow your child to choose items in shops, work out how much they cost and expected change. Have fun cooking, weighing and measuring together. Practise mental maths skills for weekly test.
