How to help your child at home...

I will be in touch with specific daily learning tasks next week. General suggestions for supporting at home are:

- Practice simple addition and subtraction to solve real life problems. Encourage children to count on from the bigger number
- Continue to practice doubles to 10/20 so children can recall facts quickly
- Practice writing full names in a cursive style. Remind children to consider letter size and position on the line
- Ask the children to tell you about the blends they have been learning in phonics
