How to help your child at home...

- Practise simple addition and subtraction to solve real life problems
- Continue to practise doubles to 20 and corresponding halves
- Practise writing full names in a cursive style
- Share traditional stories such as 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears,' 'The Three Little Pigs,' and 'Jack and the Beanstalk.' Talk about the sort of language used
