

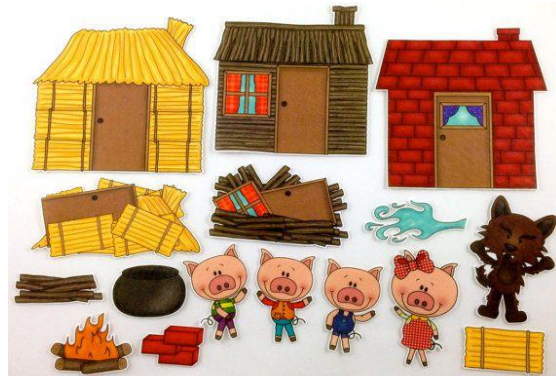
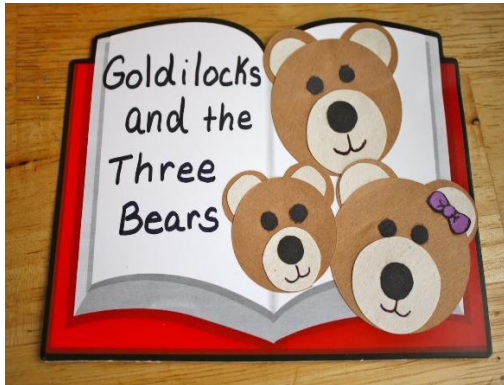
Reception Class Round-Up

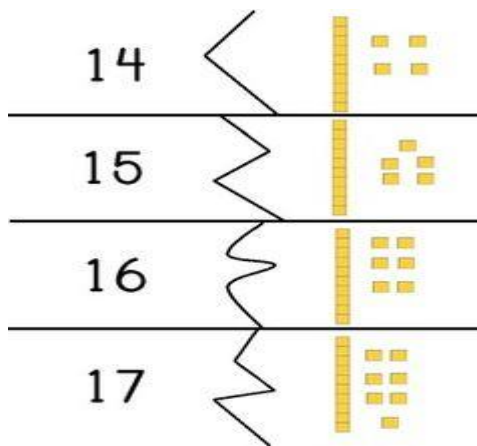


Some of the things the children have been learning

We have started our new topic 'Once Upon a Time,' and so far used the stories "Goldilocks and The Three Bears" and "The Three Little Pigs" as our focus texts. We have sequenced stories and compared size. We have thought about natural and man-made materials and which are best for building a house. We have written a list of building materials that the pigs might find useful.



We have been looking at teen numbers as a ten plus some more to reinforce place value. We have used a 100 square in our challenges and been learning to recognise and name bigger numbers.
