Some of the things the children have been learning...

We have loved the outdoor experience of forest school, and thankfully the weather has been kind. We have created a mud party with mud pies and cakes, rolled in a tunnel, climbed a tyre frame and come down a pole to name a few of our exciting adventures.



We have used the story of 'The Gingerbread Man' as the focus for our learning. We have written about the story and created alternative text to replace "run, run as fast as you can, you can't catch me, I'm the Gingerbread man."

We have been playing imaginatively in our gingerbread house role play area and identified materials and their uses in classroom objects.



In maths we have been counting in 2s, 5s and 1os. We have been learning about 3d shapes and investigating which shapes roll.



Some of the things the children will be learning in the weeks to come...

We will be substituting characters in 'Little Red Riding Hood,' and creating wanted posters for the big bad wolf. We will create a story map of little Red Riding Hood's journey through the woods.





In maths we will using addition and subtraction (up to 20) to solve simple problems. We will also be revising doubling and halving.

How to help your child at home...

- Encourage children to use expression when reading aloud
- Continue to practise writing using cursive letters. Make the purpose of writing as much fun as possible e.g. A message in a birthday card
- Practise simple addition and subtraction problems using real life scenarios
- Practise doubling and halving up to 20
